


# Joshua - A Parable for Today by Fr. Joseph Girzone

## Program Format (60-90 minutes)

Hospítalíty and fellowshíp (10 mín): Gíven the tímíng of your book club, consíder íncorporating potluck breakfast, refreshments, coffee/tea, and prayer requests.

<u>Icebreaker</u> (10 min): If the group is new, pose an open-ended icebreaker question that aims as welcoming the stranger, which is a theme of this book. As a suggestion, "When was a time that you were welcomed as a stranger to a community? How did the extend hospitality to you?"

- 5. How different do you think we are today versus then?
- 6. What acts or events did you see in the book mirror stories from the Gospel?
- F. Who do you think the audience is for this book and what do you think of the writing style?
- 8. Díd you struggle with any concepts or ídeas in this book? If so, what portions did you struggle with?
